



## **THE PERFECT LIGHT FILM FESTIVAL 2020**

The Perfect Light Film Festival 2020 will be held from Friday November 6, 2020 – Sunday November 8, 2020 with the free short film festival held on Saturday November 7, 2020 with the location to be confirmed (in light of COVID19) in Broken Hill, NSW. The location of the Festival is planned for Broken Hill, however, content may be moved online or screened at a later date online at Festival Organisers discretion.

We are inviting filmmakers of any level to submit a short film of up to eight minutes in length (including credits).

Films can be about any subject but those of a defamatory or deemed unsuitable by selectors will be disqualified at their discretion. If your film is shortlisted, it will be screened on the night to an audience expected to reach 2,000+ people (online or physical event dependant on COVID19 restrictions). Your film may also be screened at a later stage at PLFF 'pop up' cinemas. Your film will be judged on the evening by a panel of industry professionals.

### **FILMMAKERS MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES:**

- Your film can be up to eight minutes in length including credits, not over.
- Your film must be in 16:9 aspect ratio, submitted as an AVI or MP4
- Your film must be submitted and received, no later than 6pm Friday October 2, 2020.
- Entries MUST be no longer than two years from date of Festival
- You can enter as many times as you like.

### **NON COMPLYING ENTRIES**

Entries will be disqualified if:

- Your short film is over eight minutes in length (including titles and credits)
- Your entry arrives any time after the cut off date/time of 6pm Friday 2 October, 2020
- Your entry payment has not been received via Film Freeway

**PLEASE REMEMBER:**

- You must have permission to use published music in your short in the form of a licensed agreement. The Perfect Light Film Festival strongly recommends you use original or copyright free music in your film to avoid paying licence fees.
- The entrant of the short film must wholly own, or have permission to use, all script, music, characters etc...utilised in entry.
